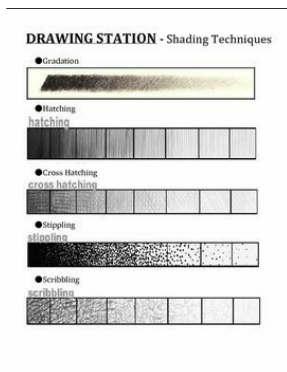
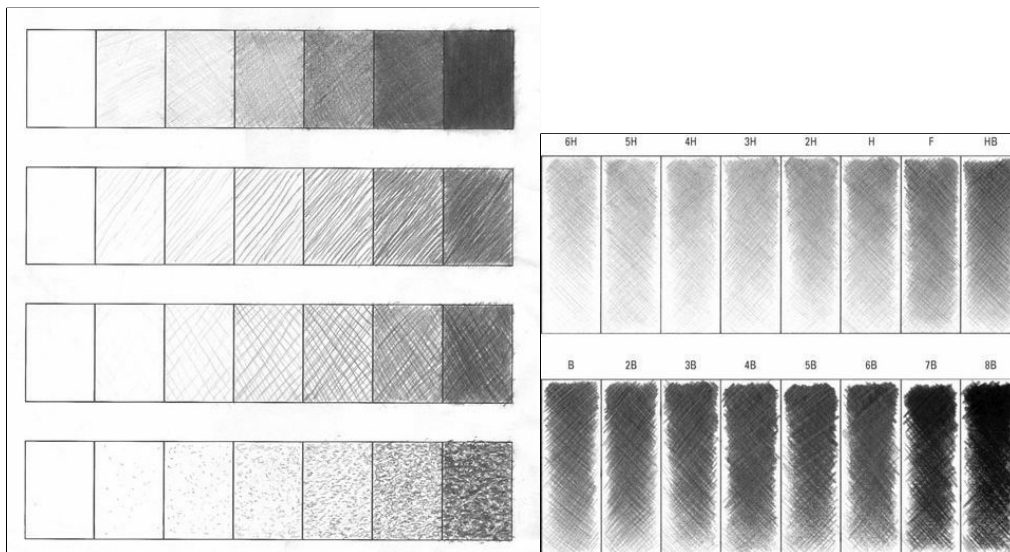
Painting
